Most of these pseudonyms can be readily documented. For example, Hugh Anderson (*Biblioworks*, Vol 4, No. 4, March 1951, pp. 10,11) lists Brady's contributions to *The Native Companion* under the various pseudonyms. In many cases, the manuscripts of the original poems or articles in Brady's own writing are amongst his papers in the National Library. Occasional reference is also made to his pseudonyms in his letters.
